



Swim Nova Scotia Competition Awards

Nova Tech Level Swimmers

- Skills Report Cards provided by home Clubs (can be accessed through Swim NS if needed)
- Best Time Ribbons provided by home Clubs (ribbons can be purchased through Swim NS if needed; labels can be provided by host Club upon request)
- Graduation medals (purchased from Swim NS):
 - Participation to Level 1 (Bronze)
 - Level 1 to Level 2 (Silver)
 - Level 2 to Age Group Development (Gold)
- Graduation Certificates: provided by Swim NS at the end of the season; presented to Clubs to present at their leisure to swimmers who have graduated out of the Nova Tech program into the Age Group Development program during the season.
- Clubs may also wish to recognize graduating swimmers throughout the season at their leisure

AA Level Swimmers- Age Group Development Program

- Best time ribbons provided to swimmers aged 12 & Under at Age Group Development Meets
- Best time ribbons (12 & Under's) and place medals (1-6/8) during finals/timed finals of individual events at AA Spring Champs & AA Winter Champs
- High Point Awards (medals) for 12 & under, 13-14 and 15 & over age groups based on aggregate high points for the top three swimmers in each age group at AA Spring Champs & AA Winter Champs

AAA Level Swimmers- Age Group Development Program

- Best time ribbons provided to swimmers aged 12 & Under at Age Group Development Meets
- Best time ribbons (12 & Under's), medals (1-3) and place ribbons (4-8) during finals/timed finals at Provincial Championships (David Fry & Ken Dunn)
- High Point Individual Awards for each Male/Female swimmer in each age group at Provincial Championships (David Fry & Ken Dunn)
- Team Awards: Awards for Top Overall Winner, Awards for Top Female Team Winner, Awards for Top Male Team Winner at Provincial Championships (David Fry & Ken Dunn)
- Swimmers of the Meet: Male and Female, swimmers of the meet, (based the current year's FINA Points) at Provincial Championships (David Fry & Ken Dunn)
